

My final conclusion is much better than I had anticipated. I think they do a really good job, even though it is a small and relatively inexpensive speaker. As I wrote, they have a warm sound and that's a plus, since I can not stand the sharp sound. The sound is very detailed and it sounds good, when you have to have it all, in live played concerts or your normal music. However, I find the lack of space and dynamics of those in relation to the other speakers, I usually listen to. It is clear that there is a big difference between what you want and like to listen to and I find them to be a good balance in between it all. However, with the lack of space and dynamics. In addition to that, it will do wonders with a bottom to them so they can do something there. It helps to lift the entire experience of sound and is quite important, so I hope one day I get the chance to listen to them with a pair of plates, which they are making themselves. We also just round the finish off and here I think the great piano lacquer is super nice, but by no means practical. The rest of the construction is beautiful and complete. The only thing I noticed was that one of the clips to the front cloth, came out with the front cloth when I took it off - it is a trifle that quick fix with a dab of glue. When I have to leave it all together, you get a really good speaker for the money and sacrifice to the bottoms of them, I'm sure that you get a setup that just plays and they doesn't require, that much of your amplifier. We conclude with a nice score of 9, a good speaker for the price.



- **The warm sound and a lot of details**
